The Doron Grant for Life, created in honor of Doron Aviman, represents an innovation that will make a tremendous difference in every orphan's life, including finding career opportunities in the Israeli tech sector – from internships to high-paying jobs.

The shared destiny of the Jewish people in Israel and the USA and the deep identification with the soldiers of the IDF and the citizens of the State of Israel has led our organization to launch a program that is groundbreaking and revolutionary in nature.

At the core of the program is deep solidarity and sincere concern for all those affected by the brutal and shocking attack by the terrorist organization Hamas on the date of Shava in October 2023.

As an organization engaged in ongoing support and assistance for Jewish orphans for 18 years, we have gained a lot of experience in generous, systematic, consistent and sustainable philanthropy. Our organization has complete faith in its ability to turn darkness into great light, sadness into joy and despair into hope.



We seek to allow these children social leadership and exit from the circles of difficulty and distress, while imparting an education with a clear occupational horizon, a connection to the world of employment through an extensive social network and connections and key people to whom we are connected in friendship or work relationships.

DORON GRANT FOR LIFE PROGRAM GOALS

- 1.** Delivering companionship, support and holistic training for every orphan who will be selected for the program.
- 2.** Providing long-term support for academic or technological studies to ensure financial independence in the adult life of the orphan.
- 3.** Imparting self-leadership and community leadership skills to each orphan, for the long term, while supporting him in the future, his or her extended family and while contributing to the community in which he lives.



DORON GRANT FOR LIFE PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- **100%** of the orphans will receive financial support throughout their studies in elementary school, middle school and high school which will be reflected in the financing of studies, at least one class a week and at least one session a week with a mentor or personal trainer.
- **100%** of the orphans and their families will receive mental and emotional support to strengthen their resilience and sense of capability.
- **100%** of the orphans will receive a high-quality matriculation certificate that meets academic standards.
- **100%** of the orphans will receive a bachelor's degree that allows for a transition to master's degree studies at a university or college recognized by the Higher Education Council.
- **100%** of the orphans will be integrated into a profession that will allow them financial independence and a contribution to the community in which they live.

THE OPERATING MODEL OF THE PROGRAM

Locating and sorting the candidates

- Through welfare and education officials in the mother city, we can locate the orphaned children, contact their official guardians and start the process of their entry into the program.
- The candidates will be from the cities of Ofakim, Sderot, Ashkelon and/or children of IDF soldiers who fell in the "Iron Swords" war in Gaza.
- Each candidate will undergo a comprehensive diagnosis at the Hadassah Institute or a similar institute to identify strengths, outstanding cognitive abilities, talents and personal interests.
- Each candidate will undergo a personal interview with a therapist (psychologist or social worker) together with the members of the association for a comprehensive explanation of the funeral process, support and assistance over the years while coordinating expectations, receiving written information and the guardian's signature on a letter of commitment to the process and its success.
- After a diagnosis, an individual companion plan will be written according to the educational, social and emotional needs that have been identified, and according to the diagnosis, a personalized plan will be designed for each orphan.
- The HM will prepare an individual data mapping format that will allow accurate, data-based identification of the orphan. From this mapping, the individual work plan for the orphan will be produced and the necessary measures will be adjusted to support and strengthen him educationally, emotionally and socially.



THE OPERATING MODEL OF THE PROGRAM

Friends for Life: Sustained Support and Sponsorship


- The organization will contact every significant person in the orphan's life, to create a holistic support network that provides a support envelope in which partners are as significant as possible.
- During the funeral and support, follow-up meetings will be held once every two months aimed at obtaining an up-to-date picture of the situation and improving the quality and accuracy of the answers given to the orphan.
- Strong families will be recruited in the orphan's environment, who will form a kind of nurturing family, who will accompany and host the orphan as needed. The rationale is to have as many circles of support, encouragement and companionship as possible along the way.
- American families will adopt an orphan for companionship support and familiarization throughout the duration of the program.
- Once every six months there will be a follow-up meeting to which all the significant factors in the orphan's life will be invited, to examine the intervention plan, get an up-to-date picture of his or her progress and update all the factors in progress and personal development.
- Mentors will be recruited for counseling and career building who will use their business connections to "open doors and occupational counseling while integrating into the world of industry and high-tech.
